

Subject: I.C.E. Requiring Foreign Exchange Students to Depart from The United States

On July 6, 2020, U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) announced that all Nonimmigrant F-1 and M-1 students admitted through the Student and Exchange Visitor Program will be required to depart the United States if their educational institution transitions to an online learning format due to public health concerns. With less than two months' notice before instruction resumes, many institutions are seeking guidance about how to navigate these new guidelines to better serve their international student populations.
